
#### **Public Art**

At Calder Branch, the program room features the Calder Community Mosaic, a striking mural made from colourful glass tiles. Inspired by Alberta's landscapes, the piece uses a palette of ten vibrant hues to reflect the neighbourhood's energy and connection, adding warmth and colour to the space.

Located on the east side of the Calder Branch, this welcoming space is bright and thoughtfully designed. A curved layout and large windows facing the entrance provide abundant natural light, while a glass sliding door makes the room feel open and accessible.
