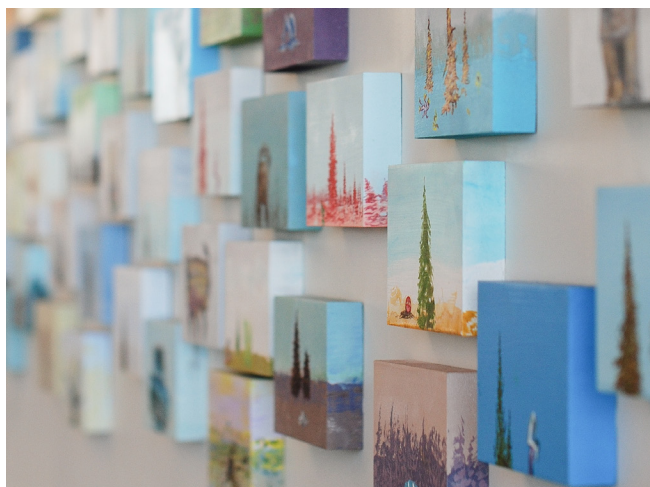


Features and Spaces

Public Art

Sculptures in Landscapes by Cliff Eyland is a striking public art installation made up of hundreds of postcard-sized paintings. Each unique piece contributes to a larger mosaic, and every painting was created in duplicate, allowing for replacements without altering the integrity of the whole—an artistic nod to preservation.

In November 2024, a vibrant art installation was added to the children's area, inspired by bugs native to Edmonton's meadows and forests. Suspended overhead, the display features flying insects with clear wings and detailed prints that catch the light and cast colorful rays onto the floor, bringing a playful and dynamic energy to the space.
