
# I Can Visit the Library

## There are many different library buildings all around Edmonton, each one looks a little different.











# The library has a customer service desk where I can find a library worker.




#### Library workers are there to help me and I can ask them questions.



#### If the library is too loud for me, I can ask a library worker to help me find a quieter space.




## **Every library has a** washroom I can use.

#### I can check out my items at the self-checkout machine or at the customer service desk.




I can keep the things I've borrowed for a little while. When it's my time to return them, I can bring them back to any library so other people can borrow them too.
